Fly Fishing 101 Zoom

All are welcome to this virtual (Zoom) class on the basics of fly fishing. You are registering for the entire FF 101 course but do not need to attend all sessions.

In this course you will be able to:

- 1. Describe how fly fishing is different from other types of fishing
- 2. Identify where to fish in the Centre region
- 3. Tie a common clinch knot and several others
- 4. Identify a brook, brown and rainbow trout
- 5. Describe some of the equipment necessary for fly fishing
- 6. Identify stream etiquette and how to handle fish safely
- 7. Recognize some of the common insects in our streams and identify the flies that imitate them.
