Members present: Bill Brusse (Pres.), Bob Donaldson, Rick Van Horn, Art Kempf, Ted Trostle, George Moellenbrock, Dick Stevenson, and Bob Eberhart. Also present were Katie Omblaski of ClearWater Conservancy and Jason Detar and Scott Carney of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission (PFBC).

<u>Purpose.</u> The purpose of this special meeting was to define the specific responsibilities of ClearWater Conservancy, PFBC and the Spring Creek of Chapter of TU in carrying out current Habitat Improvement projects.

<u>Habitat Projects.</u> Katie Ombalski distributed a document outlining the Project Schedule for 2008 and the roles and responsibilities of ClearWater, PFBC and the Chapter in carrying out the projects. After discussion, minor modifications were agreed upon, and Katie subsequently revised the document. The revised document is included as Attachment 1 to these minutes.

Art Kempf then outlined work schedules for the McCoy Area and for the Rte 550 project. He then solicited volunteers for individual task s. He subsequently prepared a list of individuals who had agreed to do specific jobs. That list is included as Attachment 2 to these minutes.

<u>Spring Creek Canyon.</u> Bill Brusse reported that the Spring Creek Alliance, of which the Chapter is a member, will sponsor a meeting to be called "Community Alternatives for The Rockview Land Transfer". Bill indicated that he would like to see the Chapter contribute \$200 toward the cost of newspaper advertising of this event. There was discussion of this idea, but no vote was taken. Bill indicated that he would conduct an email vote on this issue.

The meeting was adjourned at about 9:35 p.m.
